

Yarn quantities can vary between crocheters and are therefore approximate requirements. Use only Bendigo yarns as specified.

ACCESSORIES

A 4.00mm crochet hook or size hook to give correct tension.

TENSION

Correct tension is not essential for these throws, however, stated measurements and weights are based on this tension.

17 stitches and 8 rows to 10cm using a 4.00mm hook. Check your tension before commencing these throws and work a tension square. If there are more stitches to 10cm use a larger hook. If there are less stitches to 10cm use a smaller hook.

ABBREVIATIONS

Note: Australian/UK crochet terminology is used throughout this pattern

C1, C2, C3, C4, C5, C6 = colour 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6,
ch = chain, **st/s** = stitch/es, **tr** = treble.

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

tr2tog (treble 2 together): Yarn over, insert hook into the next stitch and pull up a loop. Yarn over, pull through the first two loops on hook. Yarn over, insert hook into the next stitch and pull up a loop. Yarn over, pull through the first two loops on hook. Yarn over, pull through the remaining three loops on hook.

THROW

(Pattern = a multiple of 14 sts + 3)

Using **C1**, make 73 (129, 213) ch.

1st Row (set up row): 1tr in 4th ch from hook, 1tr in each of the next 4 ch, [tr2tog over next 2 ch (twice)], 1tr in each of next 4 ch, *2tr in each of next 2 ch, 1tr in each of next 4 ch, [tr2tog over next 2 ch (twice)], 1tr in each of next 4 ch, rep from * to last ch, 2tr in last ch.

NOTE: you will have 2 tr in the first stitch and last stitch of each row (ch 3 counts as 1tr).

2nd Row: Ch3, 1tr in same st, 1tr in next 4 sts, [tr2tog over next 2 sts (twice)], 1tr in each of next 4 sts, *2tr in each of next 2 sts, 1tr in each of next 4 sts, [tr2tog over next 2 sts (twice)], 1tr in each of next 4 sts, rep from * to last st, 2tr in last st.

Rep 2nd row twice.

5th Row: Change to **C2** and rep 2nd row 4 times.

9th Row: Change to **C3** and rep 2nd row 4 times.

13th Row: Change to **C4** and rep 2nd row 4 times.

17th Row: Change to **C5** and rep 2nd row 4 times.

21st Row: Change to **C6** and rep 2nd row 4 times.

The last 24 rows form the colour pattern.

Repeat the last 24 rows 1 (3, 4) times.

48 (96, 120) total rows.

Fasten off, and sew in ends.
